

- Must have a full skills assessment in that occupation
- Be aged under 45 at time of invitation
- Need at least 6,6,6,6 in IELTS or equivalent unless hold exempt passport
- Passmark is 65 points minimum
- Points Test is here

- Need to get enough points for an invite (typically 75+)
- Processing time 75% within 6 months

Relative Points Test Option

489 (Family sponsored) Visa

- Need to nominate occupation on MLTSSL
- Must have a full skills assessment in that occupation
- Be aged under 45 at time of invitation
- Need at least 6,6,6,6 in IELTS or equivalent unless hold exempt passport
- Passmark is 65 points minimum (including 10 for relative sponsor)
- Points test is here

ACT Sponsorship Criteria - 190, for Canberra residents

- Non ACT residents living in Australia are not eligible
- If ex student /485 in the last 2 years then need to have lived in Act for 12 months
 - If apply after 1st July 2019 lived 2 years in the ACT
- Have worked in the ACT for 3 months (20 hours per week)
- ANZSCO 1 and 2 occupations need IELTS 7+ in each
- No dependents can be in other states or territories of Australia

NSW190 State Criteria

Northern Territory 190 Sponsorship

- Must be on NSW State list and have at least 60 points without sponsor points
- No requirement to have studied or worked in NSW
- NSW then choose based on the following criteria in order
 - Occupation
 - Points Score
 - English Language marks
 - Skilled Employment

- Studied your full course in NT for 2 years
- Non NT students in Australia need to
 - complete their course
 - Work 6 months in NT closely related to occupation

- Overseas applicants
 - Worked 12 of last 24 months in your occupation or have Australian Quals
- Processing times NT residents take 1 month, offshore take 6 months after invited
- Offshore need to meet what is on skilled list
- If not on skilled list then need good job prospects

Northern Territory 489 Sponsorship

- Studied your full course in NT for 2 years
- Non NT students in Australia need to
 - complete their course
 - Work 6 months in NT closely related to occupation
 - Are usually given 489 visa unless exceptional
- Other Non NT residents
 - 417, 457 and 462 need 6 months working in closely related occupation in NT
- Processing times NT residents take 1 month, offshore take 6 months after invited
- Offshore need to meet what is on skilled list
- If not on skilled list then need good job prospects

South Australia (Supplementary) 190

Only available if the applicants meet the requirements under one of the following category

- International graduate of SA who are still currently residing in SA and meet following requirements:
- SA qualification related to nominated occupation
- Completed Australian qual of at least 46 weeks
- At least 50% of the qualification in SA
- Must be working for 3 months in a skilled job in SA (20 hours per week) Or

Have at least 1 year of skilled work experience in the last 3 years (if claiming Australian work experience,

the last 6 months of this must be SA experience)

Or

Get exemptions** (see website)

- Graduated in SA and interstate students who are residing in SA, living and working in nominated occupation or closely related occupation for 12 months in Greater Adelaide or 6 months in country region
 - of SA (20 hrs/wk)
- Offshore interstate students who have an immediate family member permanently residing in SA for 24 months or more
- Offshore interstate students who have high points – 80 points including state nomination points)

Occupational Summary

Non Pro Rata occupations outlook

There were 70 point invitations from July 2018 to February 2019, clearing those 70 point EOIs lodged from 7th December 2017 to 9th November 2018. This went to 75 points for March 2019 and 80 points from April 2019.

We think there will be no 70 point invitations prior to the points test changes in November 2019, if the numbers resume at around 1200 from July 2019.

75 point invitations should resume for 11^{th} July 2019 invitation round which will be backlogged from 8^{th} March 2019 – a 4 month backlog. We think this backlog will reduce to 2 months by the 11^{th} October 2019 invitation round. So those who lodge an EOI at 75 points after about August 2019, may not get invited before the points test changes in November 2019

80 points and above should be invited the June round

We have not factored in yet the Partner points changes from November 2019 in our estimates and summary until we obtain more data

Remember that 489 and 190 State lists are likely to change and reopen for many regions in July 2019

The new 491 points test and 494 company sponsored visa categories start from 16/11/2019

491 - Skilled Worker Regional Provisional visa

- Points tested , (commences 16th November 2019)
- 16,000 places allocated each year , 500 different occupations
- Replaces 489 family and state sponsored visas
- Must be sponsored by an eligible relative or state authority
- Points test here

- We do NOT know how many points needed yet
- Visa will be granted for initially 5 years
- Must live and work for 3 years in regional areas to get Permanent Residence (Skilled Regional) Visa
- Will need to earn for those 3 years a minimum income each year (not announced yet)
- Can move between regions
- Cannot apply for any other skilled PR or 820 partner visa for 3 years
- Regional Australia is everywhere except Sydney, Melbourne, Perth, Brisbane, Gold Coast
- DHA Fee (1 person) \$3755
- Iscah Fee \$4700+GST, \$3700+GST (student), \$3200+GST (prev 485 client)

494 - Skilled Employer Sponsored Regional Provisional visa

- Commences 16th November 2019
- 9,000 visas allocated each year, 700 different occupations
- Replaces 187 RSMS visa
- Visa will be granted for initially 5 years
- Job offer from sponsoring company must be for 5 years
- Must live and work for 3 years in regional areas to get Permanent Residence (Skilled Regional) Visa
- Can move between jobs but will have 90 days to find a new nominator
- Cannot apply for any other skilled PR or 820 partner visa for 3 years
- Regional Australia is everywhere except Sydney, Melbourne, Perth, Brisbane, Gold Coast
- DoHA Fee (1 person) \$3755
- Iscah Fee \$4700+GST, \$3700+GST (student), \$3200+GST (prev 485 client)

We have not factored those November points changes yet into our predictions as we need more data and understanding of DHA selection policy before we are able to do that
